Midterm Study Sheet

Your midterm exam will both cover material we have studied thus far AND mirror portions of the AP exam that you will take in May. The exam is designed to take up most if not all of the allotted 90 minutes!

- SECTION ONE: VOCABULARY – 25% of grade
 - There will be approximately 50 vocabulary questions, including multiple choice and fill-in (see attached list of words).

- SECTION TWO: MAJOR WORKS OF LITERATURE WE HAVE STUDIED – 25% of grade
 - Be familiar with the plots, characters, themes, motifs, etc. of the following novels and plays:
 - Hamlet (approx. 15 questions)
 - Frankenstein (approx. 15 questions)
 - Jane Eyre (approx. 5 questions)
 - Othello (approx. 5 questions)
 - Questions will be multiple choice, fill-in, and short answer (1-2 sentences each).

- SECTION THREE: AP MULTIPLE CHOICE – 25 % of grade
 - You will have to read and answer questions about one poem and one fiction excerpt (approx. 25 questions total)

- SECTION FOUR: AP ESSAY – 25% of grade
 - Similar to the AP practice essays we have been completing all year, you will be given a prompt and a short piece of literature to interpret. This essay will be scored on the AP rubric and converted to being worth 50 points.
